



Women's Radio Program Reaches a Man's Heart

“The radio ministry in Papua New Guinea recently received a letter from a young man named Bilen which provided a “first” for our broadcast ministry” shares Nazarene missionary Jeff Myers. “Bilen wrote that he had been trying to tune in to a station and by accident tuned in to our women’s program *Cry of the Woman*.”

“I heard a very nice message,” said Bilen, “I am happy to listen to that kind of program. I open my ears attentively to what they will say.” He went on to say, “This particular program made me happy because I am going through some kind of problem. In my community people mocked me, people make enemies with me and I didn’t see a future for myself. This program made me very happy and blessed my heart. I said to myself that I have to plant a Nazarene Church in my area.”

Missionary Myers says “To this we say Praise the Lord for 2 reasons: One, a program geared for women, God is using it to also reach out to men! Second, this man has no Nazarene Church anywhere near him and because of the help he received from God through this radio program he wrote to us wanting to know how he could get a Nazarene Church started in his area!”

The village Bilen lives in is in a remote area. It would require a hike of a couple of days to get there. However, Pastor Daniel, Director of Nazarene Radio in Papua New Guinea, is already talking about making the hike with students from the Melanesia Nazarene Bible College.
