

Speaker's Script - World Mission Broadcast – Emergency Promo Kit #1

- Begin your verbal presentation by sharing the following:

Did you know that at this moment the Gospel is being transmitted around the world and lives are being changed? World Mission Broadcast (WMB) is the international Church of the Nazarene's radio, television and internet ministry, and transmits the Gospel message nearly 2 million minutes every year. Wow, that seems like a lot of air time doesn't it?

But, those 2 million minutes are currently only reaching 75 countries and 33 language groups. With a total of 192 countries and 2796 primary languages in our world today, you can see thousands have yet to hear the good news of Christ's love and redemption via our programs. Many of these people are in remote villages or dangerous political climates where even missionaries cannot go. World Mission Broadcast, with its airwave ability, is poised to go into these remote areas and reach the unreached and we need your help.

Listen for a moment to this short story that tells how God is using World Mission Broadcast to reach the unreached:

- **Reading of Story from the Field** – Read the story you pre-selected.

- **Wrap-up** - Follow-up the reading of the story by sharing this:

Since 1944 the Church of the Nazarene has been airing Christ's message of hope and holiness. Today, with advances in technology and changes in our broadcasting strategy, the cost for one minute of World Mission Broadcast airtime is \$4.00. That's right... \$4.00 to support one minute of the Gospel being aired somewhere in the world this year through a WMB program. At this rate, nearly everyone in our church can participate.

As we take our annual offering for WMB, consider how many minutes of airtime you will support – 5 minutes, 10 minutes, 30 minutes, an hour or maybe even a whole day. WMB programs are on the air solely because of the financial giving of individuals and Nazarene churches. Ask God what part he wants you to play to assure WMB programs are on the air the very moment listeners tune in searching for help, searching for answers, searching for hope.

- **Offering** - Segue now into a prayer for the offering and take the offering.

- **Thank** the congregation for their participation in helping to reach the unreached.
